  - c. Improve the process for development and/or review of FDA-regulated products

#### **INNOVATION AWARD**

The Foundation may grant the Innovation Award to an individual or organization that has made particularly innovative contributions to regulatory issues science or policy to improve public health.

- 1. The person or organization shall have made or be making truly outstanding contributions to advancing regulatory science through an *initiative* to improve the health status of individuals, targeted groups, communities, or the nation.
- \* Nominees may include individuals or organizations from government, academia, advocacy, or industry.
